Feeding America, the leading domestic hunger-relief charity in the U.S., reports that the COVID-19 pandemic will cause food insecurity in southwestern Pennsylvania to [rise by 42%](#). Between March 16 and September 30, 2020, the Greater Pittsburgh Community Food Bank delivered over 25.2 million pounds of food to 11 counties in southwestern Pennsylvania.
